

Report sterilisation campaign October 2026 Here is the report of the sterilisation project in October 2026. All projects are carried out on a completely voluntary and unpaid basis by visiting veterinarians from different European countries; They sacrifice their holiday time for this. The team that is present at these projects (catching, caring, assisting with operations and resetting) is also entirely composed of volunteers, both local and foreign. For example, interns from different types of training (veterinary assistant, animal care) make use of this. Thanks to the excellent cooperation with the local veterinary surgeon, we get access to the local veterinary practice for these projects. This time we decided to make it an extra long project. In connection with the high travel costs nowadays, this seemed to be a way to achieve a maximum result with minimal costs.

In collaboration with the local veterinary surgeon, Antonis Karaminas and an Austrian team from the K.O.S. Foundation, 3 large and several small projects have been realised. In total, together we were able to neuter/sterilise more than 1050 cats. Of these, 485 were done during the October project. In addition, 56 additional treatments were carried out (teeth, ears, eyes). This was really the largest number we have ever been able to achieve in one project. And that thanks to your support, donors and sponsors! Very, very much thanks for this, on behalf of all employees and on behalf of the cats on Samos!
